SCRUM SIMULATION

Many teams work with the scrum framework. But are these teams really 'agile'? In this simulation you will experience the problems AND solutions that many scrum teams know: different competencies in the team, problems with time-boxing, work in progress and cross-functionality.



MULTI-TEAM SIMULATION

Many organizations have to deal with multiple teams that work together on 1 product/service. What does this mean for the cooperation between these teams? What effect do the dependencies between teams have on lead time? How should you deal with capacity in a multi-team environment?



SCALED AGILE SIMULATION

Perhaps the most interesting simulation in an agile environment: the portfolio level. Does anything actually change for a portfolio manager in an agile organization? How do we match supply and demand here? And why are concepts such as triage and order points essential at this level?
